

Remote Learning at Learning4life-GY

We have a varied response to how we set remote education work based on [DfE guidance](#).

Students in all situations will follow their normal timetable and this will be accessible in school or from home via email to office@learning4life-gy.co.uk

Scenario 1 is where we are open to all students, but may still set remote education work as homework and for those students who need to self-isolate. This will be our general approach unless directed otherwise (as a school that works with 100% vulnerable learners)

Scenario 2 is where we are partially open to students. Some students will be in school, but some students will receive their education remotely. This may be where our timetables alter to ensure safety of all learners and the ability for all to access onsite learning.

Scenario 3 is where we are closed to all students. The vast majority of students will receive their education remotely.

Below you will find further details of our three scenarios.

Scenario 1

- All students will receive weekly homework that must be completed as instructed in class
- All self-isolating students will access work for **each day by accessing their Moodle page for that lesson or following direction from their student email.**
- All self-isolating students will be set work daily by their class teachers from day 2. Work can be accessed on Moodle.
- Students without access to IT will be provided with a paper pack of work upon request
- Students isolating will receive weekly phone calls from our Learning Support or Admin team

- All students will receive weekly homework that must be completed as instructed in class

For students not-attending school:

- All self-isolating students will be set work daily by their class teachers. Work can be accessed on Moodle or by their student email. This will include access to high-quality delivery e.g. a live lesson, audio provided on the PowerPoint, access to a high-quality video, direction to another resource i.e. from the [Oak Academy](#)
- Teachers will also upload tasks on to Moodle to assess the learning of students and to allow them to respond to learning gaps
- If the remote learning is required for longer than a week, students will complete one extended assignment for every four taught lessons and will be provided with feedback
- Students without access to IT will be provided with a paper pack of work upon request
- Students isolating will receive weekly phone calls from our Learning Support or Admin team
- Post-16 ESOL students will be expected to log into Microsoft Teams to join in with the live lesson

- All students will receive weekly homework that must be completed as instructed on Moodle
- All students will be set work daily by their class teachers in-line with their normal timetable. Work can be accessed by Moodle or by their student email and will be available no later than 8.30am on the day of that lesson. This will include access to high-quality delivery e.g. a live lesson, audio provided on the PowerPoint, access to a high-quality video, direction to another resource i.e. from the [Oak Academy](#)
- Teachers will also upload task sheets on Moodle to assess the learning of students and to allow them to respond to learning gaps.
- If the remote learning is required for longer than a week, students will complete one extended assignment for every four taught lessons and will be provided with feedback

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- Students without access to IT will be provided with a paper pack of work upon request
